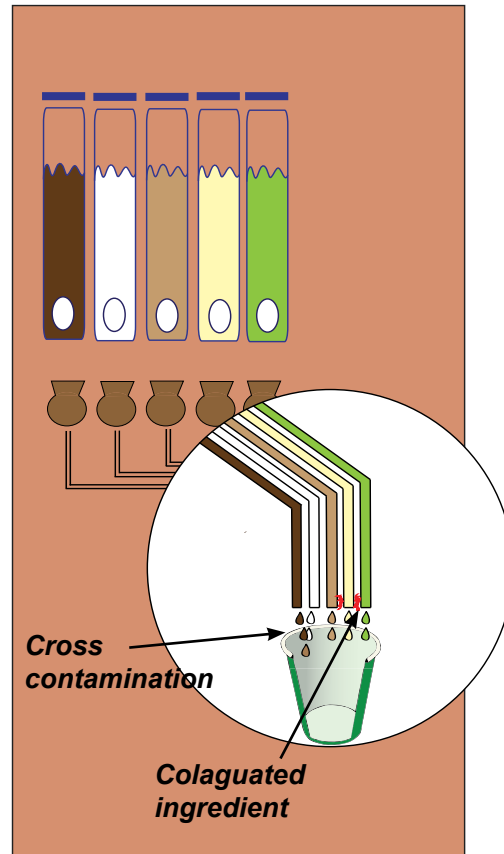


Q. When I take cold water and other drinks I get drips of tea or coffee in my water?

A. This is the most common complaint and is caused by two things, firstly the mixing system (which is cover elsewhere) but the most likely culprit is at the actual point of dispense. Because the dispensing tubes from the mixing bowl all converge to a single point cross contamination of the drinks is almost a certainty.

When dispensing a drink vibration caused by the operation of the machine will cause any remaining drips, from other dispensing pipes to drip into the drink you are currently taking.

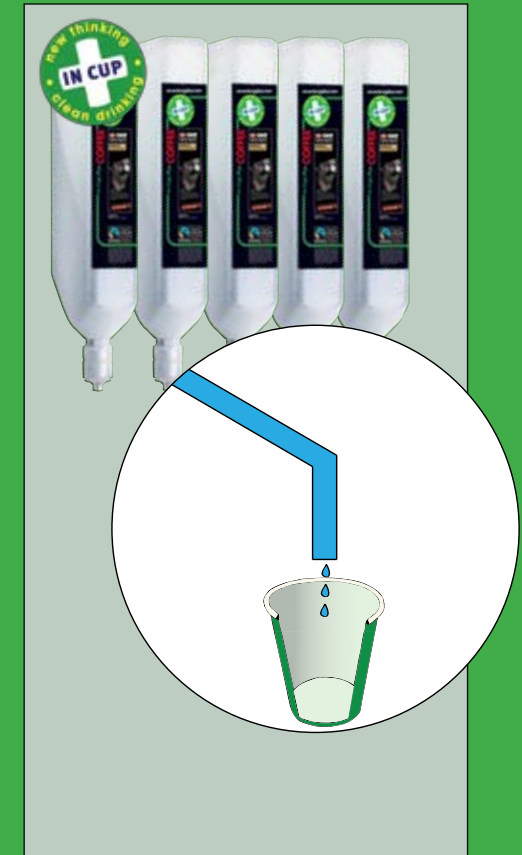
Because the drips contain residue of ingredient of ingredient bacterial growth will occur if left for any amount of time.

THE IN CUP PLUS ANSWER...
